September 2026 Major Changes

Several large August competitions have closed. September adds active HHS, DOJ/OVW, USDA/NIFA, fire-science, forestry, and community-development deadlines.

Regional Fire Science Exchange	Nonprofits, Tribes, governments and higher education.	Due Sept. 17, 2026.
USDA/NIFA Agriculture Risk Management Education	Qualified public/private entities.	Due Sept. 21, 2026.
OVW Disabilities and Deaf People	Eligible governments, Tribes and victim-service organizations.	Due Sept. 25, 2026.
National Urban & Community Forestry Challenge	Eligible nonprofits, Tribes, governments and higher education.	Due Oct. 12, 2026.

Application / Resource Readiness

Confirm applicant eligibility, geographic restrictions, registrations, match requirements, required attachments, and the official submission portal. Prepare a short project summary, work plan, measurable outcomes, budget, budget narrative, governing documents, financial records, and partner letters before the deadline.
